

Progress to Date

- 1 in 5 Rhode Islanders is enrolled in currentcare.
- Nearly 400 hospitals, physician offices, long-term care facilities, and visiting nurse agencies are enrollment partners.
- Lab data for enrolled patients are flowing into currentcare from:
 - East Side Clinical Laboratory
 - Hasbro Children’s Hospital (Lifespan)
 - Kent Hospital (Care New England)
 - Miriam Hospital (Lifespan)
 - Newport Hospital (Lifespan)

- ADT (Admission/Discharge/Transfer) information for enrolled patients is being sent into currentcare from:

Four additional care facilities will soon be sending ADT information into currentcare:

 - Women & Infants Hospital
- Continuity of Care Documents (CCD) for enrolled patients are being sent into currentcare from:
 - Cumberland Primary Care
 - Family Health and Sports Medicine

How will currentcare benefit you and your practice? Here are 8 ways:

2. You will be able to easily retrieve accurate reporting and comparison metrics, as well as look at how your practice is performing relative to others.

5. Your patients’ medical history will be available to them in an emergency—when you are not available to be their advocate.
6. Those practices that enroll the highest percentage of their patients will be among the first to have access to currentcare’s Patient Record Inquiry Service and be able to view a patient’s longitudinal clinical record.
7. Your practice will receive \$3.00 per successful enrollment. And that can add up—if you see 50 patients per day and enroll half of them, you could earn up to \$1,500 per month.
8. Your practice will benefit from advanced services, including Provider Notification. This service notifies you via secure email when a patient is admitted or discharged from a hospital. Beyond just a simple message, the notification will include a Continuity of Care Document (CCD) that contains everything that has been collected in currentcare about this patient.
