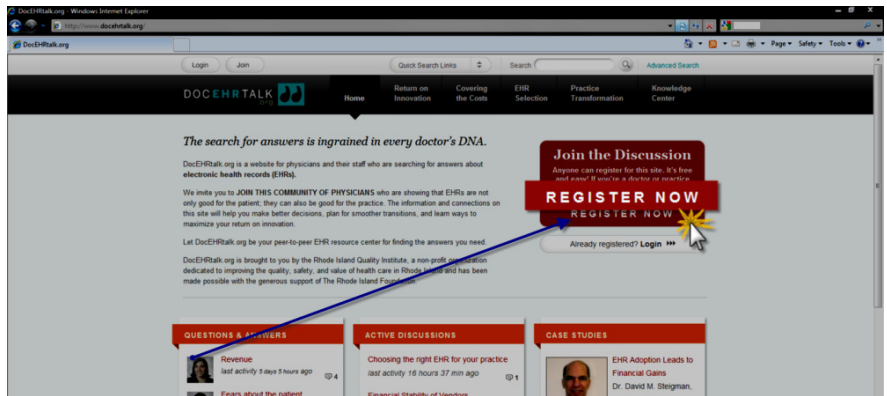


## Registration Instructions


